



Pet Policy

Pets are welcome at the Adelaide Showground Caravan Park.

In respect of other Park users, the following rules apply:

- All pets are capped at two per site.
- Pets are not permitted in the Amenity blocks, Camp Kitchen and BBQ areas.
- No dog may be left unattended at any time. Please take your dog with you if you leave the park.
- All dogs and cats, including small ones, must always be kept on a leash and under strict control whilst in the park.
- Clean up after your pets immediately and dispose of rubbish in bins provided. Doggy bag dispensers are located inside the Adelaide Showground Caravan Park.
- Dogs may be taken when access is available to the Main Arena, immediately west of the Adelaide Showground Caravan Park, or outside Adelaide Showground boundaries to be walked and toileted.
- Barking dogs can detract from the enjoyment of other park patrons. Please ensure that you keep your dog quiet. Constant barking or howling cannot be tolerated and will result in eviction.
- If, in the opinion of Adelaide Showground Caravan Park management, a visitor's dog is responsible for biting any person, the incident will be reported to the City of Unley in accordance with the Dog and Cat Management Act, 1995. The owner will be required to always restrain the dog until the City of Unley investigation is complete. Adelaide Showground Caravan Park management reserve the right to require the owner to remove the dog from the site.
- All pets, other than dogs and cats, are only permitted if prior written approval has been obtained from the Adelaide Showground Caravan Park.

If, in the opinion of Adelaide Showground Caravan Park management, the presence of a pet is causing undue disruption to Caravan Park guests, the guest and their pet will be asked to leave the Park.

Guests may be accompanied by accredited Assistance Animals throughout the Adelaide Showground Caravan Park.
